Description:

- 1. **President's Report** Ed welcomed all to the meeting. Thanks to our Fleet Captains! The Class is stable, and there were limited Rules changes last cycle. There has been a lot of winter sailing...more to come. In 2024, the Class will be adding a National Championship. This should help fill the calendar while some Championships are off continent. Looking forward to summer sailing.
- 2. Class Office Report Chris reported that the US Class has 205 members so far in 2023, including 18 Group 3, 18 Helm and 7 Associate. Look for a boost with the Midwinters and onward.
- 3. **Technical Report** Dina said the Class Rules are approved (one proposal was clerical; the other goes into effect in 2024 stating that Group 3 sailors must be 100% owners). Polk Wagner resigned

as IJ70CA Technical Chair, and Mark Foster has been appointed to fill the vacancy. Experiments are forthcoming regarding the inhauling system, based upon feedback from last year's Class survey. This is not yet at the proposal phase, and then would be voted on internationally. Most likely, this system would be an option, not a requirement. Dina reminded Fleet Captains that if an engine is changed, a new Manufacturers Declaration is needed at https://j70ica.org/manufacturer-declaration/.

4. Championship Updates –

- --2023 Midwinter Championship, Shake-A-Leg, Miami, FL, March 23-26: 60+ boats are entered, and Mark Foster is PRO.
- --2023 Corinthian World Cup, Fraglia Vela Riva, Italy, June 1-4: likely to be a Corinthian World Championship in the future. Up to 100 boats are expected in Garda.
- --2023 Corinthian US National Championship, Bayview YC, Detroit, MI, August 4-6: The NOR will be posted very soon.
- --2023 North American Championship, Chicago YC, September 18-24: 30+ boats are entered, save some money by registering by the end of this month. John added that the Verve Inshore is in August, and storage options are available.
- --2023 World Championship, St. Pete YC, St. Petersburg, FL, October 30-November 5: 90 boats on the list, and we can add more petitioners if there is drop off.
- --2024 Midwinter Championship, Davis Island YC, Tampa, FL, dates to be confirmed
- --2024 US National Championship, Fort Worth BC, TX, dates to be confirmed
- --2024 North American Championship, Vallarta YC Mexico, April 28-May 4
- --2024 Corinthian US National Championship, Corinthian YC, Cape May, NJ, September 6-8
- --2024 World Championship, Real Club Nàutico de Palma, Spain, September 14-21
